



**Informal Social Control** (Caring) – Reactions to behaviors that establish norms in a community

BASED ON

Collective Efficacy (Communicating) –A group's shared belief in its ந்ரீ capability to organize and execute actions required to achieve goals



Social Cohesion (Connected) – Building relationships with shared values, common goals, and unity



Develop Network of Neighbors (connect leaders to neighbors)
